

#### **Up Island Saturday Shuttle Going Live!!!!**

- -VTA is providing the vehicle and driver every Saturday
- -Alternating routes (Vineyard Haven/Edgartown)
- -Up Island COA will initially register clients for this option
- -Clients will call the VTA directly to sign up for weekly rides

## What is MV Connect? (A reminder....)

#### **On-Island Volunteer Driver Program (Scheduled)**

- Will provide both essential and enrichment transportation to Older Adults.
- We will utilize application specific transportation software to register and schedule participants (a first for any of our programs).
- We believe this option will **significantly reduce the cost per ride** for Older Adults and provide a mutual opportunity for **community engagement between volunteers and riders.** 
  - A similar program Vineyard Village at Home exists today but is unable to expand their capability beyond the 25-30 members they serve.
  - GoGoGrandparent will be a back-up solution when volunteer driver cancellations occur

#### **MV** Connect is in a soft launch phase

- 37 Rides Completed since it started in late January
- 10 Active Volunteers Registered today
- Major progress on learning how to use Assisted Rides software platform to schedule and request rides and have tested it with a controlled group of riders and volunteers.
- We are ready for more volunteers and participants!

#### A Reminder of Our 3 Focus Areas – 2024/2025

- We've made substantial progress at creating and maintaining a number of complementary transportation solutions – moving toward 10,000 rides per year
- Demand continues to grow, with "more needing more" further amplified by increasing island-wide awareness of these programs
- The focus on the Older Adult Transportation Coalition in 2024/2025 is to
  - "right size" our existing programs
  - o continue to ensure the financial sustainability of these programs
  - o and add vital new options, which are more cost effective and sustainable, both on- and offisland.

## More specifics for 2025

#### What's on our bucket list?

- Trial a volunteer on-island scheduled transportation program (MV Connect) UNDERWAY
- Launch Chappy Connect UNDERWAY
- Launch off-island Medical Transportation Program NO PROGRESS
- Expand shuttle on-island program -UNDERWAY
- Renew OCB transportation NO PROGRESS, DEAD IN THE WATER
- Raise awareness/education of these programs and celebrate VTA free fare program UNDERWAY



#### We are stalled on off-island transportation program

- We were not funded by MassDOT for getting this program up and running.
- Description of the program:

This program will provide Martha's Vineyard's Older Adults and Veterans of any age transportation to medical appointments off-island utilizing a paid driver and a vehicle which will riders, Woods Hole, MA. As Phase 1, the program is designed to serve those who can travel independently and will transport multiple riders, when possible, based on appointment scheduling at multiple locations.

• Need funding of \$142,000 for first 18 months; planning for fare revenue of \$40 per trip per participant (consistent with Medi-van) – IDEAS?????
